GEOGRAPHY VISION STATEMENT

At Billingham South Community Primary school, our vision for Geography is to provide an exciting curriculum that encourages children to be curious about their local and global environment. We aim to give children the knowledge and skills needed to navigate their local and global environment and for children to understand where they are situated in relation to the local community, the rest of the UK and the World. This all links directly to our school vision - Hearts in Billingham and Eyes on the World.

We will achieve this through discrete and cross-curricular teaching.

Children's learning will be inspired through a range of experiences; including Educational Visits, guest speakers and workshops.

We believe that these experiences will lead to a life- long interest and continued learning in their ever-changing world.

In KS1, children are expected to know their address, the town and country they live in. They will be able to create simple maps and know the 4 main compass points. Children will know the countries in the UK, recognise some famous landmarks, know the 7 continents and 5 oceans of the world.

In KS2, children build upon what they have learned, including knowledge of UK and other countries' capital cities and landmarks. They develop appropriate field skills, such as reading more complex ordnance survey maps.
