Each week at home your child should:

- Learn weekly spellings and times tables.
- As part of the English Curriculum, the children are expected to spell most of the spellings from the Year 3/4 and Year 5/6 National Curriculum lists in the course of their independent writing. These spellings will be tested at the beginning of the year and retested on a regular basis. Both lists can be found in their spelling books and your support with learning these is essential to their progress.
- Read for 20 minutes on at least 3 evenings but preferably 5 evenings with books monitored daily. Children are rewarded with a stamp for three reads and after 15 stamps they can choose a book from the Book Trolley.

Autumn Term Topics

History- The Maya Civilisation.
