



Term: Nursery Spring Term

Topic: Important People

Each week you should:

- Share stories with your child
- Talk to your child about their day - can they remember something they did at nursery?

Timetable:

PE Wednesday AM / Friday PM - Please send children in their PE kits on these days (black joggers/shorts. Black hoody and white t-shirt).
Forest School Wed PM (2nd 16th & 30th March) - Hats/gloves/warm coats essential while the weather is cold. Can bring wellies, we have lots of spares.

Here are some ideas for activities you can do with your child at home:

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Continue to encourage children to go to the toilet independently
- Continue to encourage children to wash their hands after going to the toilet, sneezing or coughing to promote good hygiene and independence
- Show and encourage children to put on and fasten their own coats
- Talk about who they are friends with. How are they kind to their friends?

Communication, Language and Literacy

- Copy or write their first name independently
- Talk about what they can see when walking to/from school or out and about
- Practise recognising and saying sounds s, a, t, p, i, n
- Using the sounds above, ask children what sound a word starts with e.g. what does apple start with? a a apple.

Mathematics

- Counting up to 10
- Practise recognising numbers up to 10 - you could use house numbers when walking to school
- Encourage children to use positional language (on top, under, behind, between) when talking e.g. "My shoes are under the table."
- Go on a shape hunt, can you find something that is a circle/square/triangle/rectangle

Topic work - Important people

- Draw a picture of someone important to you. Why are they important?
- Dress up as an important person and act out what they do. E.g. fire fighter, police officer, doctor, nurse
- Talk about important people and how they follow our school values (Courage, happiness, resilience, quality and responsibility)
