Here are some ideas for activities you can do with your child at home:

Personal, Social and Emotional Development	Communication, Language and Literacy
<ul> <li>Continue to encourage children to go to the toilet independently</li> <li>Continue to encourage children to wash their hands after going to the toilet, sneezing or coughing to promote good hygiene and independence</li> <li>Show and encourage children to put on and fasten their own coats</li> <li>Talk about who they are friends with. How are they kind to their friends?</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Copy or write their first name independently</li> <li>Talk about what they can see when walking to/from school or out and about</li> <li>Practise recognising and saying sounds s, a, t, p, i, n</li> <li>Using the sounds above, ask children what sound a word starts with e.g. what does apple start with? a a apple.</li> </ul>
Mathematics	Topic work – Important people
<ul> <li>Counting up to 10</li> <li>Practise recognising numbers up to 10 - you could use house numbers when walking to school</li> <li>Encourage children to use positional language (on top, under, behind, between) when talking e.g. "My shoes are under the table."</li> <li>Go on a shape hunt, can you find something that is a circle/square/triangle/rectangle</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Draw a picture of someone important to you. Why are they important?</li> <li>Dress up as an important person and act out what they do. E.g. fire fighter, police officer, doctor, nurse</li> <li>Talk about important people and how they follow our school values (Courage, happiness, resilience, quality and responsibility)</li> </ul>
