Topic: Ancient Greece

Each week you should:

- Learn weekly spellings (tested and given out on Mon)
- Read for a short time each evening (school scheme book/ your own book)
- Go on Times Table Rockstars

Each week you should:

- Learn weekly spellings for spelling test every **Monday** morning.
- Read for 5 mins on at least 5 evenings.

PE is on a Thursday. Children should come to school in their PE kit. Jewellery must not be worn for PE; children must be able to remove their own earrings.

Gardening – children have a gardening session every other Tuesday so it is important they have suitable coats, gloves, hats etc for the weather.

Here are some ideas for homework you can do with your child at home. This term please pick 3 or 4 projects to complete together and send your work back into school.

English theme:

Write a poem about *Ancient Greece* or about a *Greek Myth*.

Find about the *Greek* alphabet and produce a poster about it.

Find out what life would have been like for children in *Ancient Greece* and present your findings. E.g. poster, picture and paragraph.

Maths theme:

Find out which countries won gold/silver/bronze medals at the last Olympics. Create a table to present your findings.

Plan your own Olympic event. Create a timetable.

Design your own symmetrical *Greek* vase.

Don't forget to use TTRockStars at home to build your coins and knowledge!

Art & DT theme:

Design and make a Spartan helmet or shield.

Design and make your own labyrinth. It could be made of straw, string or wood.

Research and cook some *Greek* food.

Design your own *Greek* mask for the theatre.

Topic theme:

Find out some simple *Greek* phrases. For example, 'Hello'. Present them in a poster.

Design your own *Greek* God. Think of a name and any special abilities that they have.

Draw a map of *Ancient Greece* highlighting key cities and features.
