Here are some ideas for homework you can do with your child at home. This term please pick 3 or 4 projects to complete.

English theme

Produce a report about every-day life in Ancient Egypt.

Read a book on Ancient Egypt and then write a book review.

Write a newspaper report on a special archaeological finding. Use your imagination!

Maths theme

Produce a 'big numbers' fact sheet using facts about Egypt. For example:

- Longest river length, time line, population etc.
- · Write each number in digit and word form.
- Find out about the number system used by Ancient Egyptians.

Art theme

- Create your own tomb or coffin for a mummy.
 Remember they were decorated with a picture of the person and would show off how wealthy they were!
- Create a Canopic Jar.

Topic theme

Ancient Egyptians: Research the Ancient Egyptian hieroglyphic alphabet and write them out, then create a scroll with a message on it.
