<p>English theme</p> <p>Produce a report about every-day life in Ancient Egypt.</p> <p>Read a book on Ancient Egypt and then write a book review.</p> <p>Write a newspaper report on a special archaeological finding.</p> <p>Use your imagination!</p>	<p>Maths theme</p> <p>Produce a 'big numbers' fact sheet using facts about Egypt. For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Longest river length, time line, population etc. • Write each number in digit and word form. • Find out about the number system used by Ancient Egyptians.
<p>Art theme</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create your own tomb or coffin for a mummy. Remember they were decorated with a picture of the person and would show off how wealthy they were! • Create a Canopic Jar. 	<p>Topic theme</p> <p>Ancient Egyptians: Research the Ancient Egyptian hieroglyphic alphabet and write them out, then create a scroll with a message on it.</p>
