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Here are some ideas for homework you can do with your child at home. This term please pick 2 or 3 projects to complete together and send your work back into school.

<p><b>English theme</b></p> <p>Produce a fact file about: London, Ireland, Spain, France, Germany, Italy and/or Iceland. Try to include information on the population, languages spoken, food, music, art etc.</p>	<p><b>Maths theme</b></p> <p>Find out facts about different European countries and describe using mathematical vocabulary, for example: *Find out how temperatures change, make a graph. *Look at the time difference between different countries in Europe - what time is it here when they are going to bed?</p>
<p><b>Art theme</b></p> <p>Research famous artists who were born in Europe and recreate some of their work. You can always have a go at doing another Van Gogh style painting or another Gaudi style animal!</p>	<p><b>Topic theme</b></p> <p>Research and find out about European countries we do not have time to cover in school.</p> <p>You could think about: climate, languages, culture and food.</p>
