<p>Personal Social And Emotional Development</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Continue to encourage your child to wash their hands after going to the toilet, to encourage independence and hygiene at school</li> <li>• Continue to encourage your child to fasten their own coats</li> <li>• Play board games to encourage sharing and turn taking</li> </ul>	<p>Communication, Language and Literacy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Write lower case letters m,a,s,d,t i,n,p,g,o,c,k,ck,u,b,f,e,l,h,sh,r,j,v,y,w,th,z,ch,qu,x,ng,nk</li> <li>• Spell simple CVC words e.g. cat, hat, sat, mat</li> <li>• Write simple captions 'a cat in a hat'</li> <li>• Share your child's reading for pleasure book and talk about the setting, characters and events</li> </ul>
<p>Mathematics</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read, recognise and order numbers from 1 - 20</li> <li>• Attempt to write numerals from 1 - 20</li> <li>• Count up to 20 objects</li> <li>• Count in 2's</li> <li>• Count in 10's</li> </ul>	<p>Topic theme -Winter Tales</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Draw a picture of someone dressed for a cold winter day</li> <li>• Design a winter jumper or hat</li> <li>• Design and build a winter shelter for a polar bear</li> <li>• Finished projects can be sent in to school to share during Show and Tell</li> </ul>
