Here are some ideas for homework you can do with your child at home. This term please pick 3 or 4 projects to complete together and send your work back into school to share.

English theme

Write a diary entry as if you are a Roman soldier. What is your typical day like?
 Create a word search containing some of the key Roman vocabulary.
 Write an acrostic poem using the letters from the word 'Romans'.

Art theme

Make a drawing of a Roman god or goddess. Write a fact file about them.
 Make a Roman mosaic.
 Sketch and label a plan of a Roman fort.

Maths theme

Produce a fact sheet explaining how to use Roman numerals.
 Write some number calculations using Roman numerals.
 Find out about Roman coins and design some of your own.

Topic theme

Make your own Roman shield.
 Research the life of a famous Roman, such as Julius Caesar, Augustus, Claudius or Hadrian. Why are they remembered?
 Find out what the Romans ate. Design a menu for a Roman café.
