





Each week at home your child should: Learn weekly spellings and times tables.

As part of the English Curriculum, the children are expected to spell most of the spellings from the Year 3/4 and Year 5/6 National Curriculum lists in the course of their independent writing.

Read for 20 minutes on at least 3 evenings but preferably 5 evenings with books monitored daily. Children are rewarded with a stamp for three reads and after 15 stamps they can choose a book from the Book Trolley.
