<p>Personal Social And Emotional Development</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continue to encourage your child to wash their hands after going to the toilet, to encourage independence and hygiene at school • Continue to encourage your child to fasten their own coats • Play board games to encourage sharing and turn taking 	<p>Communication, Language and Literacy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write lower case letters m,a,s, ss, d,t i,n,p,g,o,c,k,ck,u,b,f, ff, e,l, ll, h,sh,r,j,v,y,w,th,z, zz, ch,qu,x,ng,nk • Spell simple CVC words e.g. cat, hat, sat, mat • Write simple captions e.g. a sad man • Share a story book with your child and talk about the setting, characters and events
<p>Mathematics</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read, recognise and order numbers from 1 - 10 • Attempt to write numerals from 1 - 10 • Count up to 10 objects • Recognise simple 2D shapes in the environment, circle, square, rectangle and triangle • Order objects from shortest to tallest 	<p>Topic theme -Winter Tales</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Draw a picture of someone dressed for a cold winter day • Design a winter jumper or hat • Design and build a winter shelter for a polar bear • Finished projects can be sent into school to share during Show and Tell or upload a picture onto Class Dojo • Make a bird feeder to hang up in your garden.
