English theme	Maths theme
Produce a fact file about: London, Ireland, Spain, France, Germany, Italy and/or Iceland. Try to include information on the population, languages spoken, food, music, art etc.	Find out facts about different European countries and describe using mathematical vocabulary, for example: *Find out how temperatures change, make a graph. *Look at the time difference between different countries in Europe - what time is it here when they are going to bed?
Art theme Research famous artists who were born in Europe and recreate some of their work. You can always have a go at doing another Van Gogh style painting or another Gaudi style animal!	Topic theme Research and find out about European countries we do not have time to cover in school. You could think about: climate, languages, culture and food.
