Here are some ideas for homework you can do with your child at home. This term, please pick 3 or 4 projects to complete together.

### English theme

Imagine you are an Anglo-Saxon. Write a diary entry about when you travelled to Britain for the first time.

Write an acrostic poem about the Anglo-Saxons.

### Maths theme

Look at Anglo-Saxon coins. Design your own coin or make them out of clay.

Research important events from the Anglo-Saxon period and put them in order on a timeline.

### Art and design theme

Search online for recipes of Anglo-Saxon bread.

Research Anglo-Saxon jewellery and design your own.

Research Anglo-Saxon clothes. What kinds of materials did they use? Can you design and label your own Anglo-Saxon outfit?

### Topic theme

Do some research about Anglo-Saxon place names in Britain. How many can you find that are still the same today?

Research Sutton Hoo and find out why it is famous.

Research Anglo-Saxon board games and create your own in a similar style.
