<p><u>English theme:</u></p> <p>Write a message in a bottle.</p> <p>Write a diary entry of an explorer.</p> <p>Write a post card from an explorer to someone back home.</p> <p>Create a fact file about famous explorer.</p>	<p><u>Maths theme:</u></p> <p>Give instructions to find treasure. Don't forget to use words like, clockwise, anti-clockwise, quarter turn etc.</p> <p>Sailors had to learn how to share their treasure! Can you do some division questions to practice your sharing ability? (E.g. There are 15 gold necklaces and 5 pirates. How many necklaces do they get each?)</p>
<p><u>Art theme:</u></p> <p>Create a sea or space themed diorama (a scene in a shoe box).</p> <p>Create a collage of a desert island.</p> <p>Design a space suit with gadgets.</p>	<p><u>Topic theme:</u></p> <p>List the 5 oceans and 7 continents an explorer might travel to.</p> <p>Create a treasure chest. What treasure could you put inside?</p> <p>How does a boat float? Investigate and find out!</p> <p>Can you name all of the planets in our solar system?</p>
